Company Awarded Webcasting Contracts with SBOE, PUCT**

Live coverage of the SBOE and the PUCT allows public access to meetings without the cost and time required to travel to the state capital. Meetings are typically webcast using three cameras, providing viewers with a visually robust experience of the give and take among all participants at the meetings. AdminMonitor.com also maintains archives of previous meetings, allowing viewers to watch them at their convenience. Archived meetings are divided into agenda items so viewers can quickly focus attention on items of particular interest.

The SBOE and PUCT contracts come in the wake of new government transparency mandates enacted by the 81st Legislative Session. Legislation sponsored by Burt Solomons requires the webcasting of all open meetings of the PUCT with the webcasts made available to viewers at no charge. Legislation sponsored by Representatives Donna Howard and Wendy Davis requires webcasting of all full board and subcommittee meetings of the SBOE, made available at no charge to viewers.
